BURSARY: Each year, the CVBA membership allocated funds to be awarded to a deserving application. The Bursary awarded this year will be one (1) award of \$1000.00.

Interested applicants must demonstrate a connection to the Cowichan Valley and attendance during the 2022-2023 academic year in either post-secondary education or training, in a law related field such as law school, legal assistant, policing, criminology and court services.

Qualified applicants are invited to submit an introductory letter together with a resume or other materials the applicant considers relevant. Qualified applicants will be considered in relation to the following criteria:

- Community Service
- Hard work
- Achievement in studies
- Financial need
